Sunday, March 3 – Epiphany Season Ends with the Transfiguration

Our Epiphany season this year has been a lengthy one. It has led us from the visit of the Wise Men, to the Baptism of Jesus, his miracle of turning of water into wine, his sermon at the synagogue in Nazareth, his call of the disciples, and some of his teaching in Luke's Sermon on the Plain, his version of Matthew's Sermon on the Mount. Now the season of light concludes with the transfiguration, in which on a mountaintop and in the presence of three of the disciples – Peter, John, and James, to put them in the order Luke names them – Jesus' face is transfigured by a great light, while also the Old Testament worthies, Moses and Elijah, appear alongside Jesus. The Old Testament and Epistle readings for this day (see back page of this newsletter) are also instructive in setting the context and explaining some of the meaning and interpretation of the Transfiguration.

Ash Wednesday – March 6 – Services at 12:00 noon and 6:30 p.m.

The season of Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, this year on March 6. These forty days invite us to introspection, confession, repentance, and amendment of life. It all begins with that solemn word, "Remember that you are dust and to dust you shall return." Many of us have no shortage of reminders that life is uncertain and brief. What do we make of this fact? Getting right with God and with neighbor would be a good response. The Scriptures and prayers and the imposition of ashes and Sacrament of the Lord's Supper help mark a fitting and meaningful start to our Lenten journey. We also meet Tuesdays, beginning March 12, at 5:30 for our Lenten devotional series Tuesday at the Cross.

Tuesday at the Cross March 12, 19 and 26 at 5:30 p.m.

It is appropriate during Lent to take on an added spiritual discipline, and one way to do that this Lent is to join in our Tuesday at the Cross devotional series (Tuesdays at 5:30 p.m., March 12, 19, and 26, and April 2 and 9). This half hour service includes prayer, scripture reading, silent meditation and a brief reflection from Pastor Mike Krech on ways of looking at who Jesus was and is.
