Celebrations of Communion in 2019

The session has approved the dates for the observance of the Lord's Supper in 2019. Our pattern is to celebrate Communion at least once during each season of the liturgical year and a few times during the long season after Trinity Sunday on those occasions when the lectionary Scripture readings most directly reflect the theme of believers gathering at table, or Jesus being at table during his ministry. The 2019 dates for Communion are: January 6 (Epiphany) February 3 (season after Epiphany); March 6 (Ash Wednesday); March 24 (Lent); April 18 (Maundy Thursday); May 5 (Easter season); June 9 (Pentecost); July 21; September 1; October 6 (World Communion); November 3 (All Saints); December 8 (Advent); December 24 (Christmas Eve).
