Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Worship; In Person and Live Streamed In person worship continues with the mask and distancing protocols. I believe our first four Sundays back together have been a blessing. Thank you for your faithfulness and cooperation. After last year when all our Holy Week services were recorded and online only, it was very meaningful to celebrate Palm Sunday together on March 28. That said, we continue to livestream the services for those who want and need to remain at home. That also is a faithful decision in these still uncertain times.

On Maundy Thursday, April 1, we worship at 7:30 p.m. This service celebrates the institution of the Lord's Supper. We will have Communion available for those who wish to come forward to the Communion table or the side tables to serve themselves bread and or cup. You can only receive one element and it still "counts" as Communion. This service also incorporates some of the church's ancient liturgy associated with Maundy Thursday and Good Friday and concludes with the "stripping of the church," in which worshipers remove items used in the sanctuary so that the church is bare and without decoration or adornment on Good Friday.

On Good Friday, April 2, we also worship at 7:30 p.m. This is the service of Tenebrae, a series of Scripture readings and the extinguishing of candles, emblematic of the gathering darkness surrounding the crucifixion, punctuated by three sung solos of Holy Week texts. This service also contains some ancient liturgy and practices, particularly the "loud knocking" indicative of resurrection, the first glimmer of hope of Easter.

On Easter, April 4, we worship at 11:00 a.m. Please arrive between 10:45 and 10:55 a.m., masked and prepared to take a bulletin from the tables at the doors and find a seat quickly.

The Screwtape Letters has become a Christian classic. Written by C.S. Lewis in 1943, the letters are the correspondence between the devil and a junior demon at work in the world. Obviously this is literary conceit, not to be taken literally. But the exchanges raise questions of Christian belief and conduct.
