### A Stewardship Update

Friends, thanks to your faithfulness during the pandemic years and reduced in-person activities, we have accumulated a surplus, which is allowing us to pay off the \$20,000 roof loan we took out in 2017, and puts us in good position for the five-year renewal of the loan on the McClanahan educational wing, built in 2007. The indebtedness there is \$292,000. Treasurer Jere Lawson, Assistant Treasurer John Price, and I have been authorized by the session to sign the papers for the loan renewal. We still have a surplus for emergencies and are on track to fund activities as things continue to open up. I look forward to worshiping and enjoying fellowship with all of you in the coming months.
