The first Sunday in October has been observed as World Communion Sunday, especially by American Protestants of the Reformed/Presbyterian family. The first observance of World Communion Sunday is often dated to 1933 at Shadyside Presbyterian in Pittsburgh PA, so this year marks the 90th anniversary of the celebration. The idea spread among Presbyterians and soon to other Protestant church bodies. Communion will be celebrated at our service by coming forward to receive the bread from the pastor and the cup from an elder or from the table to your left as you sit in the congregation. If you need or prefer to be served at your place, please raise a hand after others have been served and we will come to you.
