I have been given the opportunity to go on a mission trip to Europe this summer and I would love for you to partner with me! I will be traveling with Sinfonia, Evangel University's traveling orchestra to Belgium, France, Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Poland, Czech, and Hungary from May 2, 2020 to May 22, 2020.
