World Communion Sunday – October 2

The first Sunday in October has been observed as World Communion Sunday, especially by American Protestants of the Reformed/Presbyterian family. The first observance of World Communion Sunday is often dated to 1933 at Shadyside Presbyterian in Pittsburgh PA. The idea spread among Presbyterians and soon to other Protestant church bodies. Communion will be celebrated at our service by coming forward to receive the bread from the pastor and the cup from an elder. If you need or prefer to be served at your place, please raise a hand after others have been served and we will come to you. As a reminder, church doctrine has long held that taking only the bread or only the cup is still a full and valid Communion.
